CENMUN to introduce CPS students with world affairs

Nagpur: With an aim to provide a platform to students an insight into world affairs Centre Point School, Wardhaman Nagar has organized its maiden Model United Nations (MUN), 'CENMUN 2017: One World One Nation' in association with The Times of India, at its premises from November 10 to November 12.
