

# 900 student-delegates to attend CENMUN from Sept 27-29

NAGPUR: Centre Point School, Wardhaman Nagar, is all set to host the biggest CENMUN happening in Central India and Maharashtra from September 27 to 29. This grand event which will have 'The Times of India' as its print partner will feature 900 participants, called as the delegates, who are ready to create history and set a benchmark in CPS's achievements.

CENMUN is a model united nation debate platform where different schools from various places in the country take part and register themselves as a CENMUN member. Different agendas are discussed and global issues are the main topics allotted to the delegates. A total of 16 committees are participating in CENMUN 2019 along with eight

international delegates, all are the students from the Rotary exchange session, from various countries.

A completely student-organized event which will conclude on Sunday will witness the presence of the state chief secretary Ajit Nimbalkar for the opening ceremony on Friday, a youth icon Samay Raina will be present for the social fun night on Saturday and the closing ceremony will witness the presence of Union minister Nitin Gadkari on Sunday.

Students from Std XI and XII have arranged the biggest MUN held in the country. There are 10 associates under the secretary general Hiten Muniyal and vice-secretary general Priyank Shah. A new addition in the committees this time is the FIFA which is a non-conventional committee. A large number of young crowd will be present in the CENMUN 2019.

A 9 to 9 schedule will be observed in the three-day programme, where 9am to 5pm will be dedicated solely to conferences and debate sessions and evenings will be for social fun on Saturday and a prize distribution function along with the closing ceremony on Sunday.

The members of CENMUN hold high expectations and are excited to host this third session with the inclusion of international delegates. Shared his views with TOI , secretary general Hiten said, “I am very happy to be the SG this year. I hold high expectations from the delegates as they are dedicated participants.
